Class Regulations

1. Required Range Equipment:

- a. Eye Protection Safety glasses, prescription or types purchesed at sporting goods store, etc.
- b. Ear Protection Ear muffs designed for shooting or the foam/sponge ear plugs.
- c. Baseball cap or hat with a brim.
- d. Handgun (see regulations on the first page of the application). Caliber .22 up to .45. It must pass a safety inspection.
- e. Ammunition a minimum of 100 rounds in the caliber for your handgun. (Basic Pistol and Personal Protection in the Home)
- 2. General
 - a. The Instructor may remove any student at any time from the class. If there is any action or activity that the Instructor deems unsafe or inappropriate, the student will be asked to leave the class.
 - b. Dress appropriately for the weather—remember the range portion is conducted outside.
 - c. No alcholol or drugs! Any prescription or non=prescription medicine that advises against driving must not be taken prior to the range/shooting.

Class Information

- 1. Unless otherwise stated, the class begins promptly at 8 am. Please arrive a few minutes early. This is an 8-hour class and that includes the range time. Depending upon the number of people in the class, we may finish a few minutes early or late! We do have a short drive to the range.
- 2. You will be furnished a class book and other information, but you will need a pen or pencil to take additional notes, a highlighter (color of your choice), and a pencil with a good eraser for the exam.
- 3. Coffee will be provided and water is available, but if you wish something else feel free to bring your own drinks. There is a refrigerator to keep them cold and a microwave to heat them up if necessary.
- 4. We will take a 30-minute break for lunch. If everyone brings a sandwich (or lunch items) then that will save time and we can go out to the range sooner. You may keep your lunch in our refrigerator.
- 5. Bring your handgun in a case or range bag—but DO NOT BRING AMMUNITION INTO THE CLASSROOM. The instructor will inspect your handgun during the lunch break. Store your ammunition separately until we arrive at the range and you are instructed to bring it out.
- 6. Since we will be using an outdoor firing range, the instructor may reschedule the range time due to incliment weather or rain. If you need to schedule a separate range time be sure to visit with the instructor prior to class.
- 7. If you have not fired a handgun before or you feel you need additional coaching, the instructor may offer the NRA First Steps Pistol Orientation Class prior to the class. Please check with him as to the schedule. NOTE: the NRA Basic Pistol Shooting Course is required before taking the NRA Basic Personal Protection in the Home Course.
- 8. Additional classes are offered for those who wish to gain a better mastery of their firearm.

Do NOT bring ammunition into the classroom!
